**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

The sample(s) MEETS the following requirement(s):

- The mechanical hazards requirements of 16 CFR 1500, "Federal Hazardous Substances Act Regulations".
- The flammability requirements of 16 CFR 1500.3(c)(6)(vi), "Flammable solid" (FHSA regulations).
- The mechanical hazards requirements of ASTM F963-07 E1, "Standard consumer safety specification for toy safety".
- The cleanliness requirements of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, PA Code, Title 34, "Stuffed toy regulations", Section 47.317 (tolerances).
- Customs requirements on the placement of country of origin marking, 19 CFR 134.11, "Country of origin marking".
- The packaging and labeling requirements of the Uniform Packaging and Labeling Regulation.

The sample(s) was tested to the following requirement(s) and the data provided is for informational purposes only:

- The flammability requirements of 16 CFR 1610, "Standard for the flammability of clothing textiles", in the original state (FFA regulations).



Note: No accessible surface coating was present on the received sample(s). Consequently, the heavy metals content analysis of surface coatings according to 16 CFR 1303, "Ban of lead-containing paint and certain consumer products bearing lead-containing paint", and ASTM F963-07 E1 "Standard consumer safety specification on toy safety", Section 4.3.5, was not conducted.

Note: At the request of the client, the following testing of the sample(s) was not conducted:
